## New York State Pistol/Revolver License Recertification

All pistol holders should have received a letter from the state police by now with the recertification directions. Pistol/Revolver License Recertifications are currently only required for those permits originally issued before January 15, 2013. If your permit was issued before January 15, 2013, the deadline to submit your recertification is January 31, 2018. If your permit was issued on or after January 15, 2013, the deadline to recertify is five years after the date the permit was issued. As a permit holder, it is your responsibility to recertify your permit whether you receive a notification letter or not. Failure to recertify within the deadline will result in the revocation of your pistol/revolver license.
